CHS are holding a community Rainbow Run. Participants of all ages and fitness levels can walk, skip, run or cartwheel their way through numerous colour stations in the beautiful settings of the Gleeson Wetlands. Participants will be doused in fabulous rainbow colours and enjoy the benefits of being active in the great outdoors.

As well as the community Rainbow Run, you and/or your children may also choose to enter the children's dash (Primary school age and lower) or the open dash (high school and adults) which will be held around the course prior to the colour being released!

The colour used in the Rainbow Run is a fine corn starch – nontoxic and food grade product. Safety information is available upon request.

Participants are encouraged to wear white clothing to enhance the effect. Participants will be

required to provide their own safety glasses, and bandana (to cover mouth and nose if required) and we recommend snap lock bags for keeping mobile phones safe - however, it will be individual's responsibility to utilise this safety equipment. Participants will

be able to buy breakfast on the day, and a cake stall will also be available.

The Participants will be very messy and coloured at the end of this event, please be mindful of this, participants clothing may be stained or ruined so please make the appropriate considerations.

NOTE: maybe some plastic bags or an old sheet to sit on in the car on the way home!!

Everyone under the age of 18 will be expected to be signed in by a parent or caregiver and supervision of primary school children is required for the event. All runners will need to complete the attached entry form and return on the day.
